Governor Wilson then shared her personal passion - Polio Eradication. She found her personal through the experience participating in a Rotary mission to inoculate children in India. This mission continues to this day. Desiree noted that Rotary's work nearly achieved our goal - only 2 cases of polio identified this year (one in Pakistan the other in Afghanistan) since the last polio case was identified 32 weeks ago. Part of her success is in fundraising - she does a ride in Arizona focused on polio and shared that, because of matching-gift support, every \$100 given through Rotary to address polio is matched up to amount to \$750!
