After we disbanded because of Covid, we recreated ourselves making sandwiches for the food bank to give on their late night – Wednesday – so families could have something to eat as soon as they got home. So the first week we had 65 guests, the second week 85 guests, with over 100 plates served. June we will serve on the 23rd and 30th. July we are in full swing of every week. I manage the kitchen on week 2 if anyone is interested in joining me!
