


Disaster Relief Team Progress- Lombok: chaired by RC Lombok Mataram – Pres. Ace Robin Providing shelter boxes – 672 units, mattresses- 120-blankets- 300/ Rotary Wooden Houses- 212 units (project to be completed by Oct. 2018 with 50 more wooden houses to be built)- Donations: Rp. 101,232,560

The need is still very great in Lombok and RCBS has a direct link to RC Lombok for Relief Aid. With over 400,000 people homeless and over 600 dead that we know of, it will take continuous aid to this area for months to come.











Relief Plan: Short term: Mattresses, Tarps, Medicine, Food & Water/ Long term: 1,000 Survival Kits,1000 Rotary T-shirts, 1000 towels, 1000 First Aid kits, 1000 Water Bottles, 1000 raincoats, 1000 soaps, tooth paste, shampoo/ Medium term: Mobile Cinic and Trauma Healing, Rotary Wooden Houses

Without the most recent counts of over 2,000 dead and thousands still missing, it is hard to evaluate the magnitude of the loss in Sulawesi from the tsunami for now, but it is great.

"RISKS ON FINANCIAL INVESTMENTS"



"What is an investment?" Investment is time, energy or matter spent in the hope of future benefits actualized within a specified date or timeframe. Areas of investment are durable goods (gold, silver, etc.), real estate, industry, venture capital and financial products. Crypto currencies ae not yet qualified under investments because of the huge volatility. Every investment is a RISK. The higher the return, the higher the risk.

The Do's and Don'ts are:

- Divide your money in 3 and keep one third in the bank.
- Divide all the investment amount in different baskets.
- Never borrow money to buy stocks or any other financial product
- If you invest in stocks, never buy only 1 type of shares
- Never buy impulsively
- Never put all of your money in one investment company or broker
- Do not interfere if you have no knowledge
- Work only with people you can trust
- Don't let yourself be pressured by others
- Never panic... have patience
- Take advice... better to pay a commission than to lose your money
- Prepare a plan
- Set and respect your limits
- Don't be greedy
- Never invest with money you might need tomorrow

Advice from Warren Buffet is:

- Invest in yourself!
- Cash is a BAD investment (surplus cash)
- Wait for the right pitch





- Invest in productive assets
- Stocks: Evaluate the company first, before you look at the price
- Accept your mistakes
