



Rotaract is a Rotary program that brings together people ages 18 and older to exchange ideas with leaders in the community, develop leadership and professional skills, and have fun through service.



The idea for Rotaract emerged in the mid-1960s, building on the success of Interact, Rotary's service program for young people, which was founded in 1962.

Rotary members were looking for a way to promote Rotary to college students and other young adults who were over the Interact age limit.

The answer was Rotaract: a service program for men and women ages 17-25 that would be sponsored by local Rotary clubs. (The age requirement later changed.)

The first Rotaract club was certified by Rotary on 13 March 1968 at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte.
