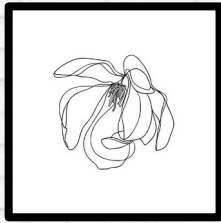

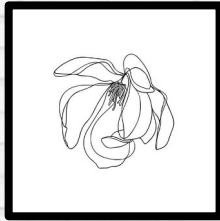

Contributions to The Rotary Foundation support efforts to build stronger, healthier, and more peaceful communities.



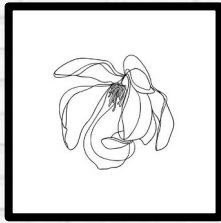

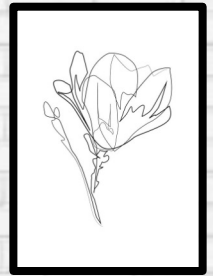


1. Ending Polio





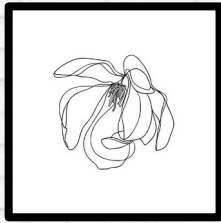
Rotary has been fighting polio since 1979 and has a long-standing commitment to ridding the world of this disease.







Rotary and its partners have helped reduce polio cases worldwide by more than 99% since 1988.



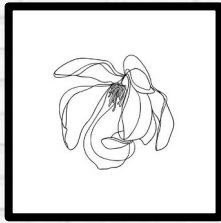


2. Supporting our grants and programs



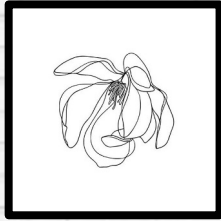


Your contributions make it possible for The Rotary Foundation to offer a variety of grants that help fund local and international humanitarian projects, programs, scholarships, and vocational training teams.



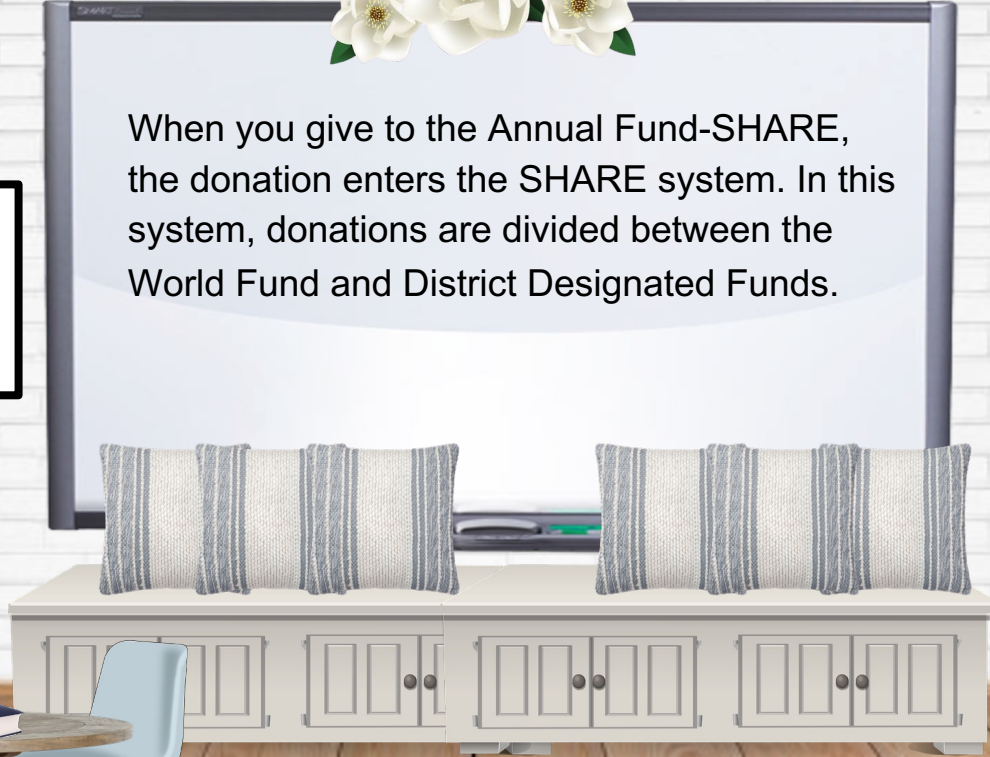
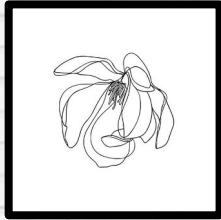


The Annual Fund

Foundation does.



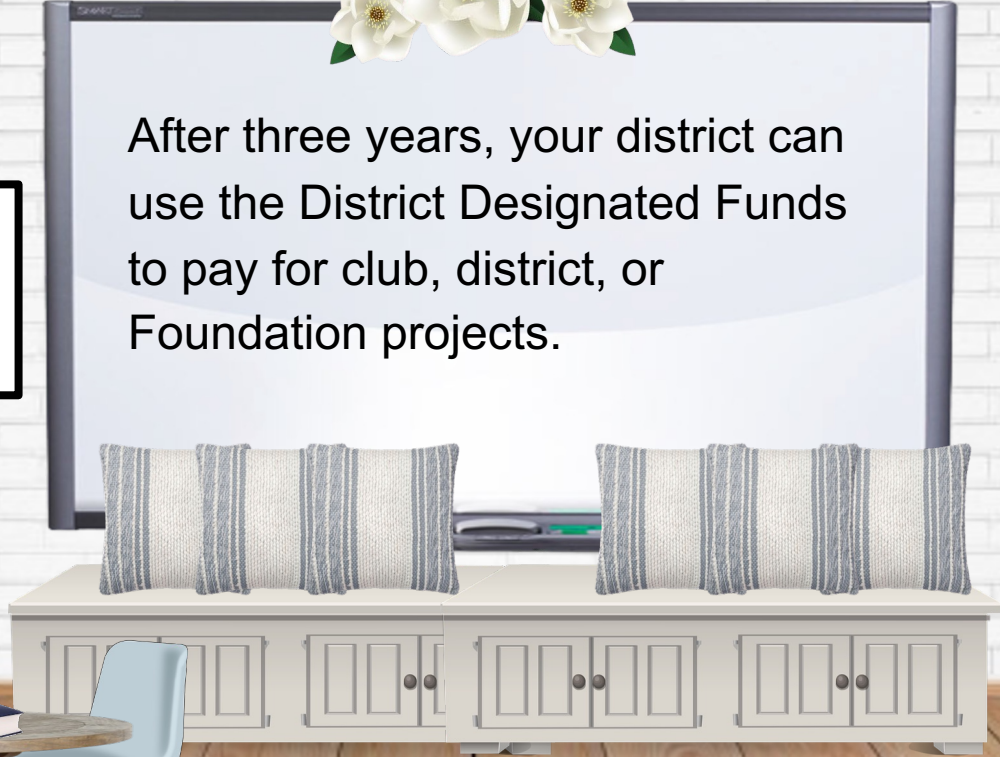
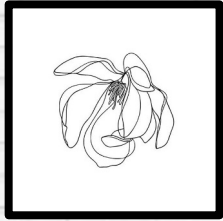


When you give to the Annual Fund-SHARE,

system, donations are divided between the
World Fund and District Designated Funds.



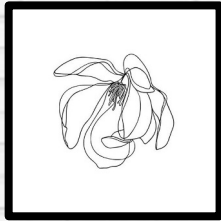


After three years, your district can use the District Designated Funds to pay for club, district, or Foundation projects.



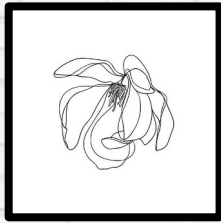
Here's an example of a project that's supported by donations to the Annual Fund.

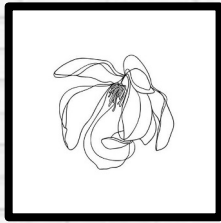
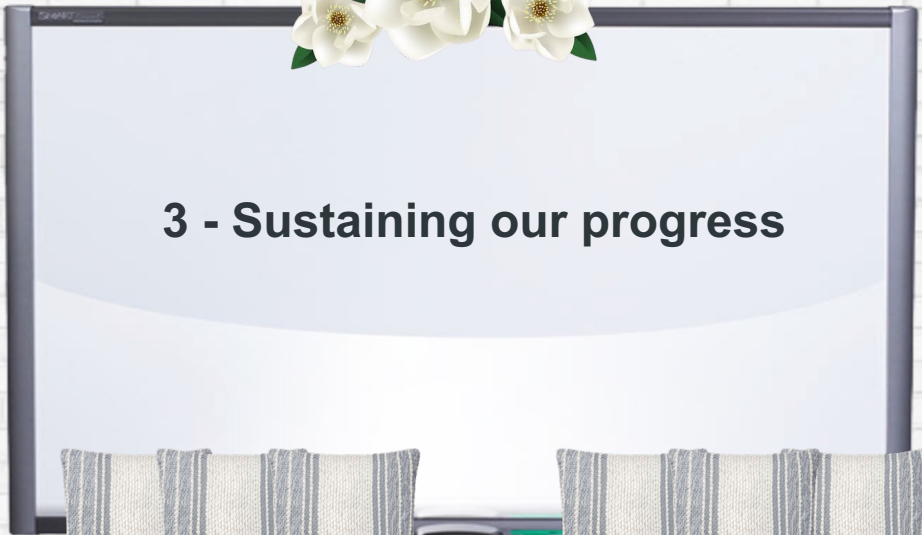

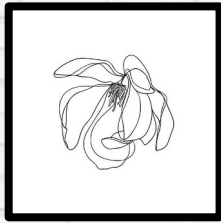






The Endowment

It's important to ensure that the Foundation can continue our vital grants and programs far into the future. If you want to help, you can choose structured gifts that provide ongoing income.

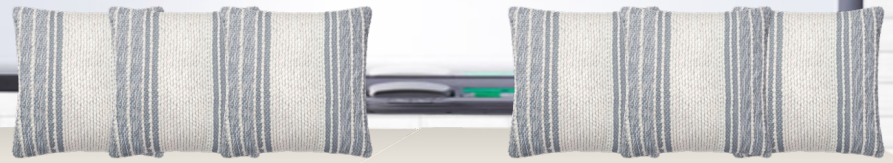
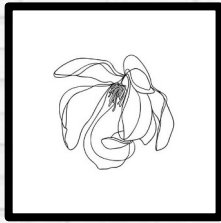

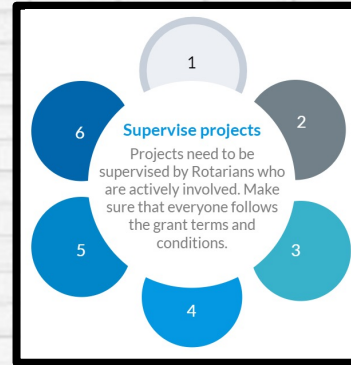


Donations to the Endowment continue to support Rotary programs after your lifetime. Making a gift to the Endowment now or through your estate plan will give Rotary programs a stronger future.



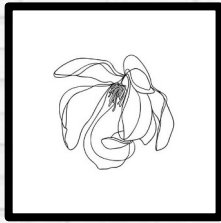
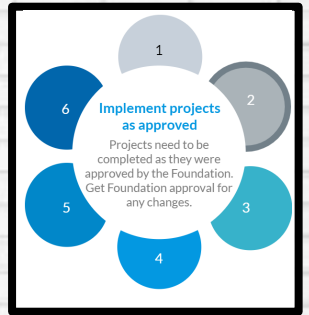

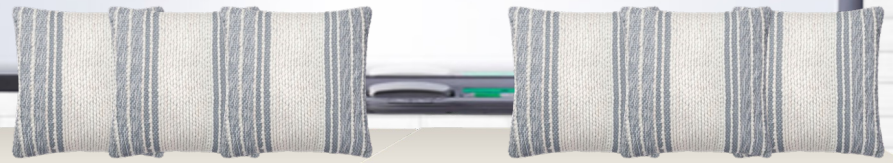
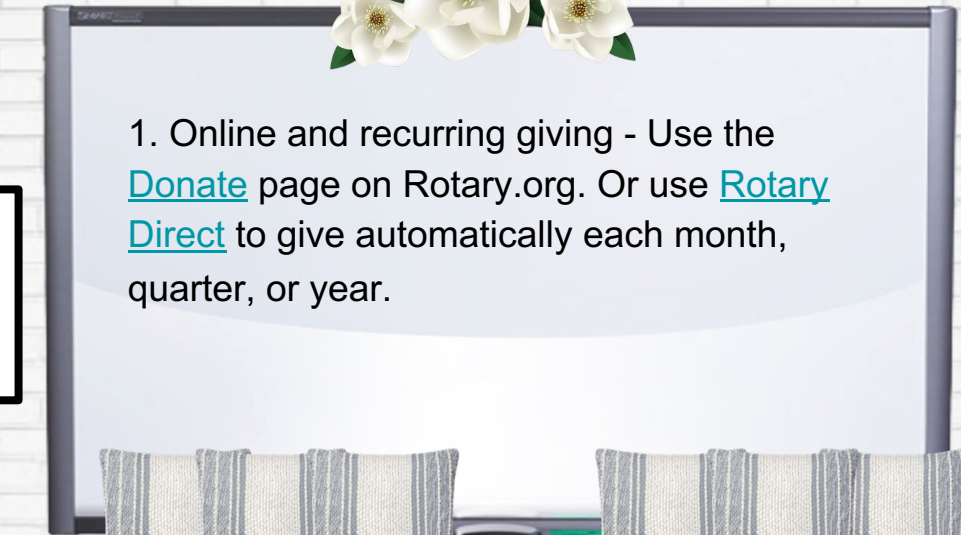
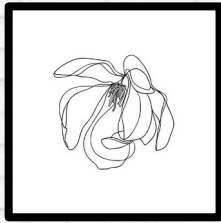


Ways to Give



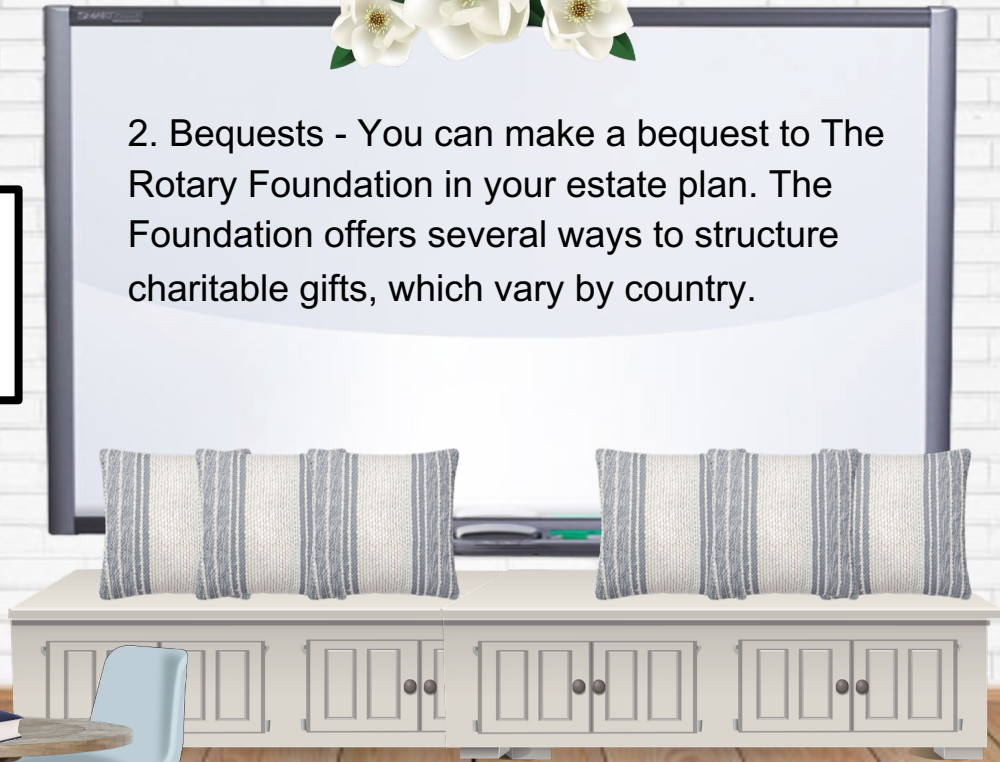
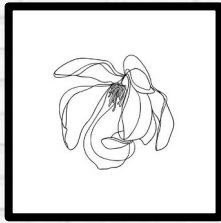


1. Online and recurring giving - Use the [Donate](#) page on Rotary.org. Or use [Rotary Direct](#) to give automatically each month, quarter, or year.



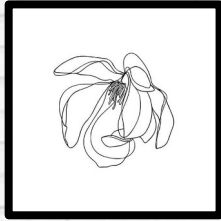


2. Bequests - You can make a bequest to The Rotary Foundation in your estate plan. The Foundation offers several ways to structure charitable gifts, which vary by country.





3. Employer matching gifts - [Check if your employer does](#) and, if so, use the match to maximize your gift.



4. Directed gifts and named endowment funds
- Endowed funds are invested in perpetuity, with part of their earnings spent on a designated program. Directed gifts are spent in their entirety, usually in the next Rotary year.





5. Memorial and tribute gifts - A gift to The Rotary Foundation is a meaningful way to honor a family member or friend.

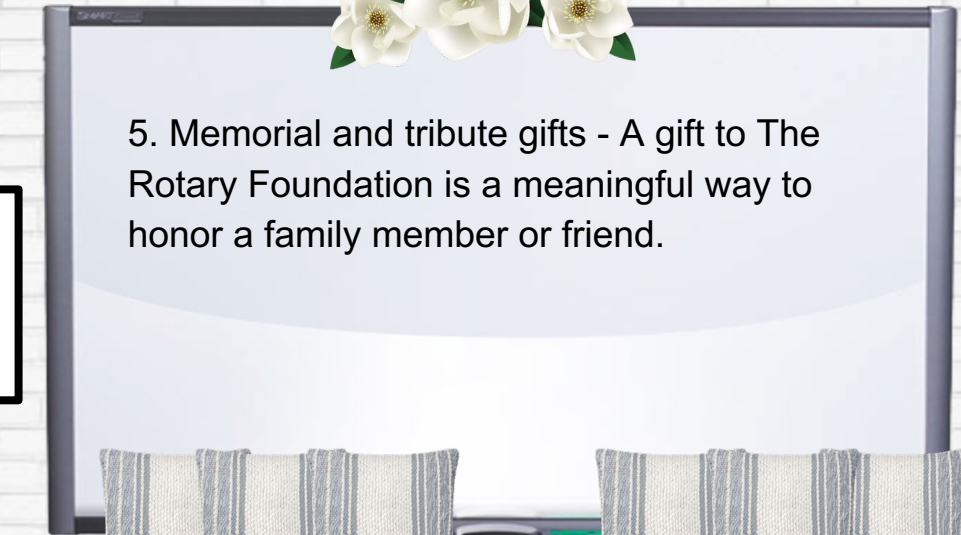
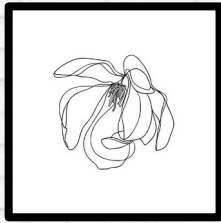

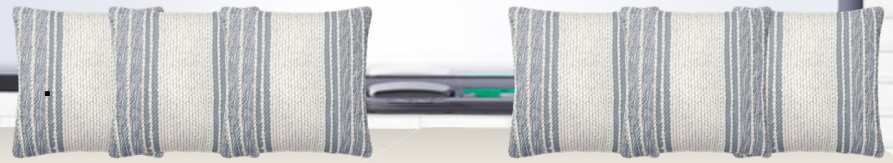
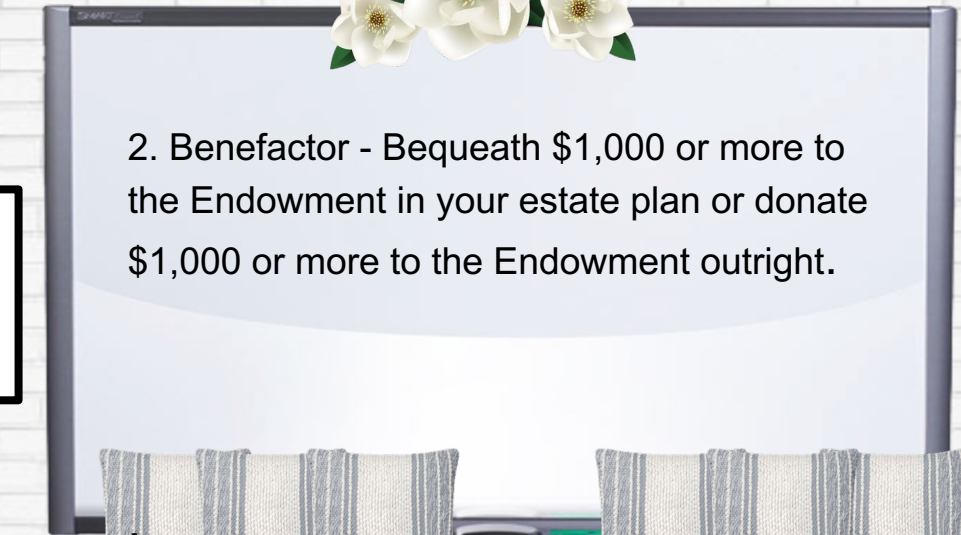
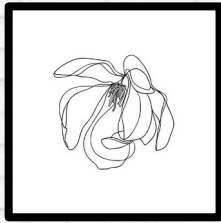



1. Rotary Foundation Sustaining Member –
Become a Sustaining Member by contributing
\$100 or more to the Annual Fund each Rotary
year.



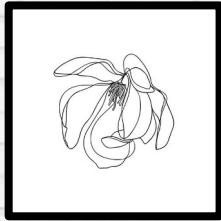


2. Benefactor - Bequeath \$1,000 or more to the Endowment in your estate plan or donate \$1,000 or more to the Endowment outright.



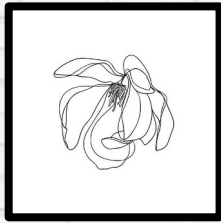


3. Paul Harris Fellow - Anyone who contributes at least \$1,000 over time to the Annual Fund, the PolioPlus Fund, or an approved global grant can become a Paul Harris Fellow. You can make someone else a fellow by contributing in their name using Foundation recognition points.



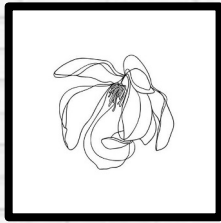


4. Multiple Paul Harris Fellow - When you give additional gifts totaling \$1,000 or more to the Annual Fund, PolioPlus, or approved Foundation grants, you are recognized as a multiple Paul Harris Fellow.



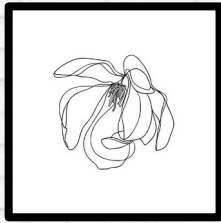


5. Paul Harris Society - The Paul Harris Society recognizes donors who **notify The Rotary Foundation** of their intention to contribute \$1,000 or more every year to the Annual Fund, the PolioPlus Fund, or approved global grants.



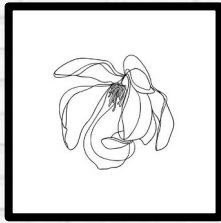


6. Polioplus Society – recognizes donors who notify The Rotary Foundation of their intention to contribute \$100 or more every year to Polioplus Fund



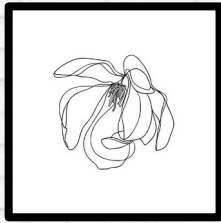


Additional Recognition levels for donors include



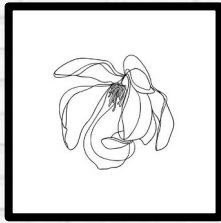


1. Major Donor - The Rotary Foundation recognizes individuals or couples whose combined giving has reached \$10,000 as Major Donors, regardless of how they directed their gifts. This level can be achieved only through personal contributions, not through recognition points.



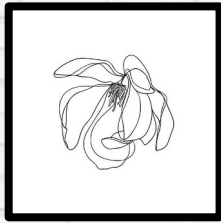
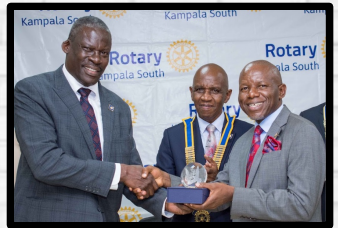


2. Bequest Society - Couples or individuals who have made commitments in their estate plans that total \$10,000 or more are recognized as Bequest Society members.



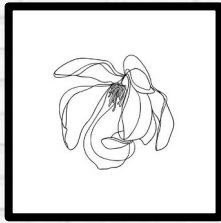


3. Arch Klumph Society - Donors who contribute \$250,000 or more become members of the Arch Klumph Society. This special recognition includes induction into the society and inclusion in the interactive gallery at Rotary International World Headquarters.



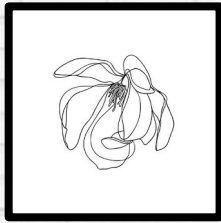


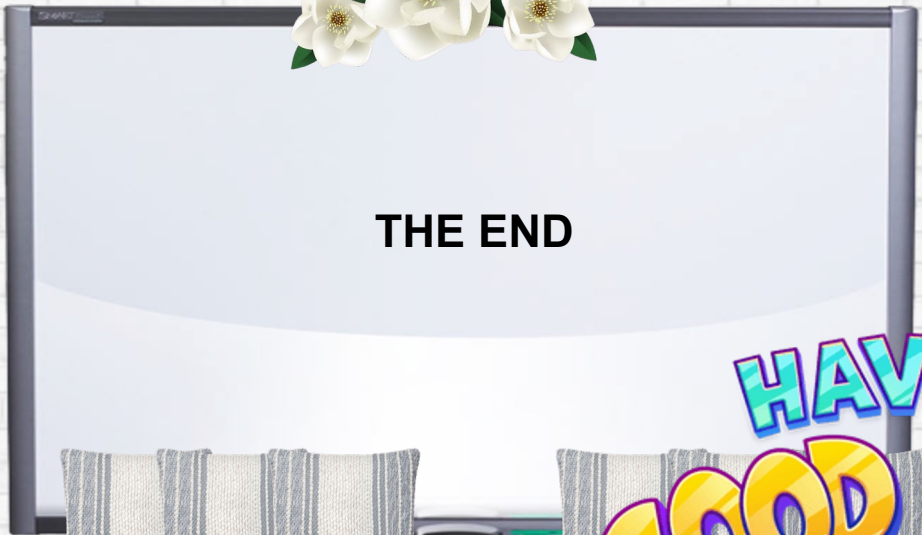
4. Legacy Society - Individuals or couples who have substantiated a future gift of \$1 million or more to the Endowment are invited to join the Legacy Society. Legacy Society members receive special recognition items and all the benefits that are afforded to Bequest Society members
