The Object of Rotary


The object of Rotary is to encourage and foster the ideal of service as a basis of worthy enterprise and, in particular, to encourage and foster:


Paul has extensive knowledge in Statistics and Computer Sciences and has previously worked for BMR and is currently the IT Manager at PKF Uganda.

Paul has served in various capacities, including Club Admin, Treasurer and Club President. Paul joined the club in November 1995.He was loaned the classification of Accounting


ICT OFFICER




ROTARY FRATERNITY ANNOUNCEMENTS
