

**OUTCOME OF THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE MOTIV COMMUNITY NEEDS
ASSESSMENT WITH MUKKI SKILLS DEVELOPMENT CENTRE HELD ON THE
28TH DECEMBER, 2023 AT MUKKI VILLAGE, MANAFWA DISTRICT.**

Mukki Skill Development Centre administration wishes to thank MOTIV Uganda (Innovation village) for having visited Mukki community. The children and youth were over joyed, excited and filled with high expectations from MOTIV Uganda. Thirty-seven (37) children and youth were present out of forty (40). Some children and youth had travelled for christmas holidays to be with their parents in different villages and districts, especially those who lived with their grandparents within Mukki community.



MOTIV Uganda representative Ronald Madanda was introduced to the 37 children and youth with whom they discussed various vocational skills such as tailoring, computing, football, soap making and so on. They were later on divided into five groups and each discussed the various proposed skills. Each group selected their respective skills of interest. A final skill list was generated as follows;

- MOTIV Uganda will train the boys in **brick making, wood carving and crafts and carpentry** in the short run. In the long run, they would train them in **metal welding** skills.
- MOTIV Uganda will train the girls in **soap making, hair dressing, crouching and weaving** in the short run. In the long run they would train them in **tailoring** skills.

The catering and baking skills proposed was not selected because the Mukki women group is already doing catering and baking. The children and youth that were interested in catering and baking were encouraged to join the Mukki women group to support them during their catering and baking activities.



Ronald encouraged the children and youth to mobilize more youth to attend the skills training sessions at the centre in order to reach a larger mass. The Mukki youth agreed to jointly mobilize their friends within the community. Mukki troupe then perform for Ronald and showcased their singing and dancing skills so far acquired. The meeting was adjourned for lunch and a visit to their respective homes commenced thereafter.

Out of eight (8) villages, Ronald was able to visit four (4) villages due to the limited time and the distances. He visited Mukki Seroma (approx.1 km), Buwanga (approx. 10 km), Mabubu (approx. 17 km) and Buselenge (approx. 4 km) village. All villages surround Mukki village in Manafwa district. Ronald was also shown the land allocated for the children and youth where their skills will further be developed.

The MOTIV community needs assessment successfully ended at 7:30 p.m. with a commitment from MOTIV Uganda to start the skills training from January 2nd, 2024 at 10:00 a.m. This has given hope to the Mukki children and youth to keep actively engaged in a more productive way and not engage in acts of theft, hooliganism and the like.

A case in point is over the Christmas festive season a Mukki troupe boy aged 17 years together with his friends were imprisoned because they ganged up and beat up a boda rider near a burial

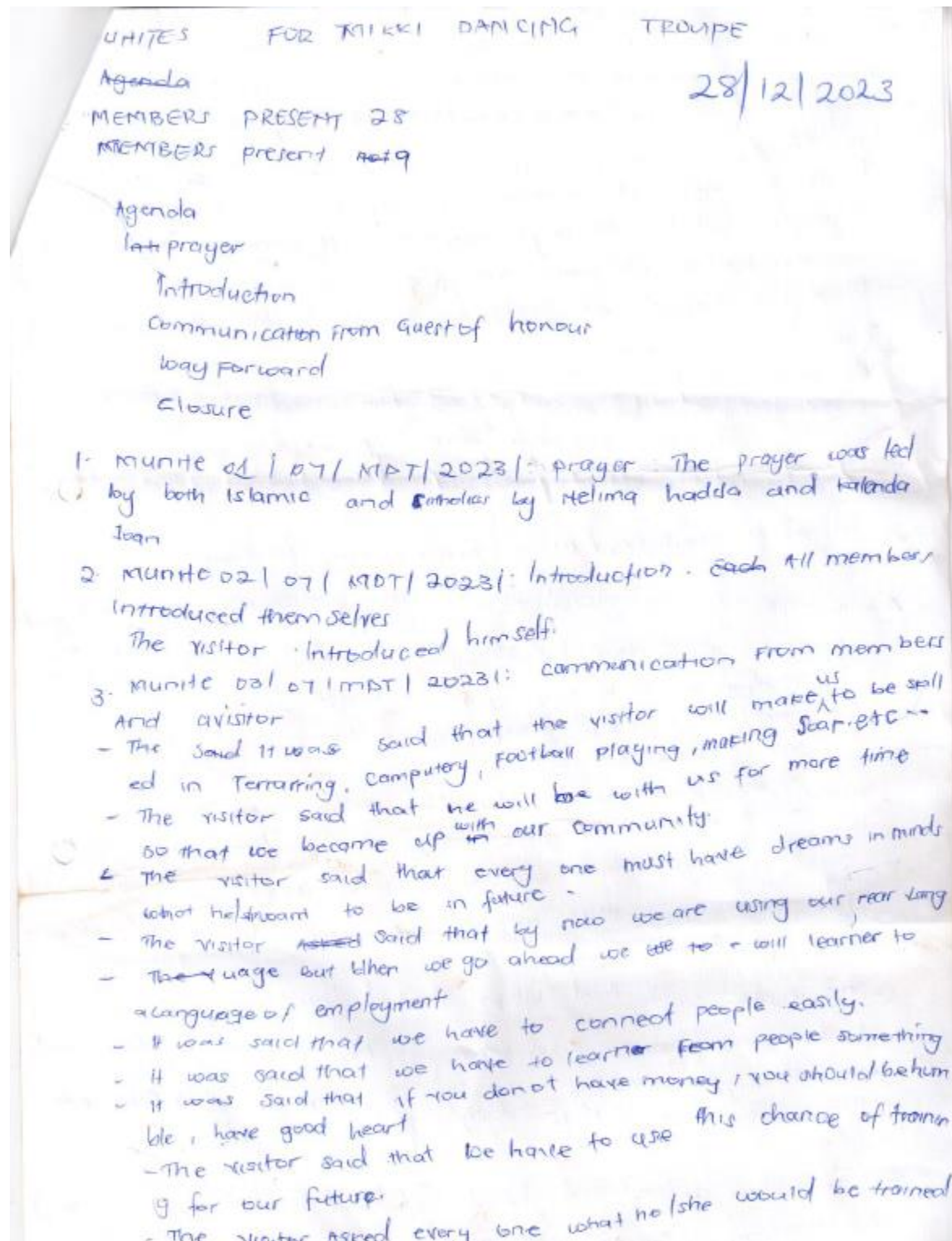
site who found them along the road side. Unfortunately, from my understanding, the boda rider did not make it out of hospital and the boy spent the entire Christmas season behind bars. Fortunately, he was release at a police bound of 1 million which money is expected to be paid by his grandparents. Such vises are largely influence by bad peer pressure, alcoholism and drugs with the community. With MOTIV skill development engagement we hope that majority of the youth will productively utilize this training during the long holiday. We too thank the Rotary Club of Kampala South for the initial to transform the Mukki children and youth through MOTIV partnership.
