Description	The Project is to improve the current solid waste management measures to enhance health and well-being of refugees and host communities through appropriate and reliable innovative solid waste management options.
Location	Kyaka II Refugee Settlement in Kyegegwa District
Beneficiaries	124,194 refugees and 1,256 Asylum seekers
Objectives	 To enhance appropriate solid waste management through applying the 3Rs Reduce, Re-use, Recycling, Reduce with the trading centers. To enhance the capacities and competencies of Community Groups through trainings in Group dynamics, record Keeping, effective community engagement skills and the 3R principle. To establish and create linkages between community groups and business entrepreneurs in sustainable solid waste management. To promote household level appropriate management of solid waste through sorting and use of HH level rubbish pits.

- Procurement of roller bins (15 compartmentalized metallic bins), One Briquetting machine extruder, One Honey comb machine, One Solid Waste Drying House
