The Rotary Club of Plainsboro was chartered in the year 2002. It is now named as Rotary Club of Plainsboro - North & South Brunswick. The Club is a part of the Rotary International organization.

Rotary International is the world's first service club organization, with more than 1.2 million members in 33,000 clubs worldwide.

Rotary club members are volunteers who work locally, regionally, and internationally to combat hunger, improve health and sanitation, provide education and job training, promote peace, and eradicate polio under the motto **Service Above Self**.

In 2002 a few people of Indian origin - Andy Iyengar, Dinesh Mittal, Seema Singh, Anil Srivatsav, Sudhakar Venkatesh, Nagender Racherala and Suresh Reddy, living in *Plainsboro*, *South Brunswick*, *North Brunswick*, *Edison*, *Franklin Park*, *and North New Jersey* decided to charter a new Rotary Club in Central New Jersey with the intention of servicing the local and international community. The club started out with three members and rapidly grew to about 20 members living in various parts of the state. The club is open to all people. Most of the current members are of Indian origin.

The club meets weekly. Besides working on various humanitarian charitable projects, the club provides an excellent opportunity for networking with the mainstream Indo American community.

Since its inception, the Rotary Club of Plainsboro has proudly sponsored a number of local and international charitable projects. We strive to work in the five *Avenues of Service* – Club service, Community service, Vocational service, International service and Youth service.

All project funding decisions are based on a simple four way test:

- Is it the TRUTH?
- Is it FAIR to all concerned?
- Will it build GOODWILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?
- Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?

SAMAR is an official recruitment group of the National Marrow Donor Program and works closely with patient families and community organizations to organize bone marrow/stem cell donor recruitment drives. They serve patients who need a hematopoietic stem cell transplant for leukemia, fatal blood disorders and other conditions requiring a cellular transplant for an improved life.

"End Polio Now" Campaign: We participate in this Rotary International effort. We organized an 'End Polio Now' fundraising campaign and donated \$500 to Rotary District 7510.

The eradication of polio is Rotary International's longest standing and most significant efforts. Rotary along with partners, such as the **Gates Foundation**, has helped immunize more than 2.5 billion children against polio in 122 countries and has reduced polio cases by 99.9 percent worldwide.
