Food for Thought

THIRTY-THREE YEARS ON

The Rotary Club of Surfers Paradise Central sprang into action in September 1977. It was a significant time for Australia: Sir John Kerr was Governor General, Malcolm Fraser was Prime Minister and Sir Joh Bjelke-Petersen, Premier of Queensland abolished inheritance tax and banned street marches and demonstrations.

It was the Queen's Silver Jubilee year and she visited Australia in March to open Parliament.

Sydney's Granville rail disaster shocked the country, the world's first personal computer was shown in Chicago, Elvis died in Memphis and *Star Wars* opened in cinemas around the world.

On 20 October 1977, Rotary International certified the charter of a new lunchtime club of 25 members—the Rotary Club of Surfers Paradise Central.

For 33 years that name has been at the fore of many projects and events on the Gold Coast and internationally. A few are recalled in the following pages of this final issue of the Surfers Paradise Central Club Bulletin.


