

Join the Rotary E-Club of One World

The purpose of the Rotary E-Club of One World (District 5240) is to extend Rotary to business, professional and community leaders in any Rotary District who are unable to meet traditional attendance requirements or are seeking a traditional Rotary club alternative. The primary focus of this Rotary club is to encourage and support peace and conflict resolution efforts throughout the world.

To be a member of the Rotary E-Club of One World means...

1. You live or do business in ANY Rotary District in any country of the Rotary world.
2. You are a contributor to society in your profession, occupation, industry, business, or community.
3. You are committed to the personal ethic of [Service Above Self](#), [The Four-Way Test](#), and support the [Object of Rotary](#).
4. You are willing to participate regularly in the Rotary E-Club of One World community and, as appropriate and feasible, you are willing to accept and perform your fair share of the Club's tasks and responsibilities. Rotary International guidelines state that you must attend at least two meetings a month. In the case of the E-Club of One World, meeting content is posted each Friday on the Club's website and is sent to each member in an email message; it is your responsibility to read/view/listen to the entire content and to register your attendance upon completion. Make-up meetings are also available on the website; alternatively, members may attend another club's meeting or perform volunteer service acceptable to the Club.
5. You accept that all club programs, forums, business, and communications are conducted in English.
6. You are willing to make financial contributions to support Club projects and to The Rotary Foundation every year.
7. You are prepared to pay current dues of \$66 US per quarter to support the operating costs of Rotary International, Rotary District 5240, and the Rotary E-Club of One World. New members are required to pay a one-time initiation fee of US\$50. New Generation members and those who are former Rotaractors are on a separate dues structure.
8. You accept that, for the purpose of Rotary administration, you will be considered a member in good standing of District 5240, California USA, regardless of your state or country of residence.

9. You have regular access to the Internet and are willing to acquire the necessary skills to participate in the activities of the Rotary E-Club of One World.

10. You agree to report service performance on behalf of the Club or your community to the Club Secretary each month and to register meeting attendance as instructed on the website. The minimum requirement is 12 hours per quarter which is equivalent to 1 hour per week. The Secretary sends members an email reminder each month with a link to report service performance.

11. You are to never allow anyone to enter the members' section of the website or the Facebook Clubhouse either by giving your password or sharing your computer; this would breach confidentiality laws in the United States and some other countries.

Membership in the Rotary E-Club of One World should not be considered as an "easy" option. Requirements for admission to any Rotary club are stringent. For current Rotarians wishing to transfer to our Club, the Rotary E-Club of One World adds the additional requirement of a letter from the club's president or secretary indicating the Rotarian is a member in good standing in his/her current club. Our rigorous screening of applicants is a necessary first step to ensure excellence.
