MINUTES: August 12, 2014

President Wes Brooks presided over the meeting. Thanks to Lynn Walton who gave the invocation and to Lamar Evans who led the Pledge of Allegiance. Thanks to Lucy Parkman for serving as our greeter today.

Wes reminded members of the BIKE-A-THON which is coming up on November 1. Audra Cummings then introduced today's guest speaker, Roland Johnson. Mr. Johnson is the Outreach coordinator for the REACH Program at Pine Grove Behavioral Health & Addiction Services.

The REACH program is an expressive therapy ropes course used primarily in the treatment of residential and outpatients at Pine Grove. However, according to Mr. Johnson the ropes course

is open to the public and he will also make arrangements to bring his unique training techniques into your place of business. The course is designed to build self-confidence, communication skills, self-esteem and trust building skills. A portion of the course is used in the Area Development Partnership's Leadership Pinebelt training.

Roland reports that REACH is used weekly for the 60 to 90 residents of Pine Grove. The course brings realistic experience challenges and horizons to the participants. In the end he ties all of their experiences into real life issues.

Roland concluded his presentation by sharing an exercise used in the training program with every member. Using ropes, teams of two were challenged to untie themselves using their skills of communication and leadership. He noted that members smiled, communicated and most importantly asked for help when they needed it. Knowing you need help and seeking that help is a major component of the recovery process used at Pine Grove.




