Robert announced that the one-half day District Seminar will be held on August 13th. Board and committee members and other club members interested in attending should mark the date on their calendars. The Seminar will be held at Pearl River Community College.

PROGRAM SUMMARY

Richard Jones than introduced today's guest speaker Dr. Jim Weir the Associate Dean for Student Affairs, and Professor of Pathology, Histology, and Oral Health at William Carey University College of Osteopathic Medicine.

Dr. Weir reported that Mississippi leads the nation in deaths due to heart disease and ranks second in the nation in accidental deaths. He noted that our state lies in the heart of the largest area of the United States that is medically underserved. It is the mission of the College of Osteopathic Medicine to put well trained doctors into these underserved areas with the primary focus being an area 60 miles within a radius of the University.

The average faculty member of the College has 25 years of teaching experience. The three buildings that were a part of the original master plan for the College are now fully constructed and occupied. The first building constructed was the Academic Building, the second was the Clinical Science Building and the third building to be completed was the Administration Building.

Although the curriculum is a discipline based curriculum, students will also have exposure to distinctive curriculum elements such as Oral Health, Regional Issues in Medicine, Disaster Preparation and Public Health and Third World Mission Medicine. The College has contracted with regional medical centers within the service area where students will spend their third and four year practicing medicine either where they came from or where they plan to practice medicine.

Of 110 students in the 2014 class, 46 are from Mississippi. In the 2015 year class 108 applications were accepted out of 1,724 applicants. Thirty-five of the 2012 class are from Mississippi. After the first year of the program Dr. Weir reports that 96% of their students will return for their second year of medical school.
