Beginning in 2012, Pinebelt FCA along with a number of community sponsors host a similar retreat for the female leaders of high school campuses in the Pine Belt. He attended North Forrest and Southern Miss, where he lettered every year in cross country, indoor and outdoor track. He was inshrined in the USM Athletic Hall of Fame in 2001. He and his wife Shelia are the parents of four boys. They are members of Grace Temple Church.

Sean Priebe then introduced today's guest speaker, Major General Johnny Sellers, Retired. Major General Sellers serves as co-founder and a board member of the Wounded Minutemen of Mississippi. The non-profit organization was found in in 2010 and exists to provide assistance to any wounded soldier or airmen living in Mississippi. Major General Sellers stresses that the organization's primary goal is to assist the families of these wounded warriors. The organization is managed by a 14 member board representative of the entire state of Mississippi.

Ninety-nine-point-seven percent of all the money raised by the organization goes to help the families of those selected to receive the assistance. To qualify for assistance through the Wounded Minutemen of Mississippi organization you must be within the boundaries of Mississippi. You must have been wounded by enemy fire and have received a Purple Heart for your injury.

Out of 38 applicants for benefits last year nine families were assisted. Major General Sellers says the organization doesn't like turning a candidate down but the organization is limited by the amount of money it raises each year. This year the nine candidates each received \$5,000 to be used in any way they need to spend the money.

The organization sponsors a golf tournament each March and hosts raffle events throughout the year to generate money for their program. They also enlist contributions of both money and in-kind services from area businesses.


