# LAST WEEK'S PROGRAM

Erik Graham then introduced today's guest speaker, Jennifer Payne, the Centennial Celebration coordinator for the University of Southern Mississippi.

According to Jennifer USM began by legislative action as Mississippi Normal College in 1910. In 1924 the City of Hattiesburg was the highest bidder for the location of the college. Hattiesburg beat out Laurel and Jackson for the college location. The Hattiesburg bid included \$250,000 and assistance with land acquisition. The university began with 120 acres of harvested timberland.

The name changed to the State Teachers College and remained by that name until 1940. It offered a two-year teachers certification program. In 1928 the college obtained accreditation. Beginning in 1942 the college had a close relationship with the military, as evidenced in some of the campus' architectural designs. The location of Camp Shelby was critical to the war efforts during World War II. The institution had another name change and became Mississippi Southern College. Finally in 1962 another name change occurred and the College became the University of Southern Mississippi.

Jennifer invited club members to participate in the year-long centennial celebration that will begin in January, 2010. There will be fine arts programming, sporting events, the unveiling of a new museum feature. Founders Day will be celebrated on March 30.


