

Requirements for the 2024 Northlake-Mandeville Rotary Club College Scholarship Application Process

- SAT and/or ACT test results.
 - o For ACT scores: Submit a screenshot from a personal computer (not a smart pad or smartphone) of your score on the online display from ACT, Inc. The screenshot needs to include your first and last names (upper right-hand corner of online ACT results screen), total score, and subtest scores. Superscoring is allowed.
 - For SAT scores: Submit the downloaded PDF score report form available on the College Board website or a copy of the score report that was mailed to you from College Board. Superscoring is allowed.
- Official high school transcript of all four years of high school.
- A typed, double-spaced essay of 500 words or less expressing how the Northlake Mandeville Rotary Scholarship will help you achieve your goals in life.
- You must submit with your application, a copy of the first page of your Student Aid Report (SAR) issued by the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- Applications must be postmarked Friday, March 8, 2024 or emailed by midnight on Friday, March 8, 2024.
- Finalist interviews will be scheduled for Sunday, April 7, 2024.
- The Rotary Scholarship is a \$12,000 award, paid to the college of the recipient's choice in \$1,500 semester installments for a maximum of 8 semesters. The student must be full time as defined by the college of their choice and maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA. The scholarship winners

are required to attend the Annual Northlake Mandeville Scholarship Banquet to receive acknowledgment as a scholarship winner. Winners are also required to attend a Rotary lunch meeting twice a year to report on their activities and pick up their scholarship checks. **Attendance at the Annual Scholarship Banquet and two Rotary meetings per year is mandatory.** The Banquet is traditionally held on the last Sunday in April. This year's Annual Scholarship Banquet is going to be held Sunday, April 28, 2024.

- Scholarship winners must provide a copy of their college grades after each semester.
- Applicants must reside in the Mandeville, LA area, which is defined as South of I-12, North of Lake Pontchartrain, West of Bayou LaCombe, and East of the St Tammany Parish western boundary.
