



Requirements for the 2025 Northlake-Mandeville Rotary Club College Scholarship Application Process

- **SAT and/or ACT test results.**
 - **For ACT scores:** Submit a screenshot from a personal computer (not a smart pad or smartphone) of your score on the online display from ACT, Inc. The screenshot needs to include your first and last names (upper right-hand corner of online ACT results screen), total score, and subtest scores. Superscoring is allowed.
 - **For SAT scores:** Submit the downloaded PDF score report form available on the College Board website or a copy of the score report that was mailed to you from College Board. Superscoring is allowed.
- **Official high school transcript of all four years of high school.**
- **A typed, double-spaced essay of 500 words or less expressing how the Northlake Mandeville Rotary Scholarship will help you achieve your goals in life.**
- **You must submit with your application, a copy of the first page of your FAFSA Submission Summary issued by the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).**
- **Applications must be postmarked Friday, March 7, 2025 or emailed by midnight on Friday, March 7, 2025.**
- **Finalist interviews will be scheduled for Sunday, April 6, 2025.**
- **The Rotary Scholarship is a \$12,000 award, paid to the college of the recipient's choice in \$1,500 semester installments for a maximum of 8 semesters. The student must be full-time as defined by the college of their choice and maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA. The scholarship winners are required to attend the Annual Northlake Mandeville Scholarship Banquet to receive acknowledgment as a scholarship winner. Winners are also required to attend a Rotary lunch meeting twice a year to report on their**

activities and pick up their scholarship checks. **Attendance at the Annual Scholarship Banquet and two Rotary meetings per year is mandatory. The Banquet is traditionally held on the last Sunday in April. This year's Annual Scholarship Banquet will be held on Sunday, April 27, 2025.**

- **Scholarship winners must provide a copy of their college grades after each semester.**
- **Applicants must reside in the Mandeville, LA area, which is defined as South of I-12, North of Lake Pontchartrain, West of Bayou Lacombe, and East of the St Tammany Parish western boundary.**
