



Requirements for the 2026 Northlake-Mandeville Rotary Club College Scholarship Application Process

- **SAT and/or ACT test results.**
 - **For ACT scores: Submit a screenshot from a personal computer (not a smart pad or smartphone) of your score on the online display from ACT, Inc. The screenshot needs to include your first and last names (upper right-hand corner of online ACT results screen), total score, and subtest scores. Superscoring is allowed.**
 - **For SAT scores: Submit the downloaded PDF score report form available on the College Board website or a copy of the score report that was mailed to you from College Board. Superscoring is allowed.**
- **Official high school transcript of all four years of high school.**
- **A typed, double-spaced essay of 500 words or less expressing how the Northlake Mandeville Rotary Scholarship will help you achieve your goals in life.**
- **You must submit with your application a copy of the Federal Student Aid FAFSA Submission Summary**
- **Applications must be emailed by midnight on Friday, March 6, 2026.**
- **Finalist interviews will be scheduled for Sunday, April 12, 2026.**
- **The Rotary Scholarship is a \$12,000 award, paid to the college of the recipient's choice in \$1,500 semester installments for a maximum of 8 semesters. The student must be full-time as defined by the college of their choice and maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA. The scholarship winners are required to attend the Annual Northlake Mandeville Scholarship Banquet to receive acknowledgment as a scholarship winner. Winners are also required to attend a Rotary lunch meeting twice a year to report on their activities and pick up their scholarship checks. ****Attendance at the Annual Scholarship Banquet and two Rotary meetings per year is mandatory.**** The**

Banquet is traditionally held on the last Sunday in April. This year's Annual Scholarship Banquet will be held on Sunday, April 26, 2026.

- **Scholarship winners must provide a copy of their college grades after each semester.**
- **Applicants must reside in the Mandeville, LA area, which is defined as South of I-12, North of Lake Pontchartrain, West of Bayou Lacombe, and East of the St Tammany Parish western boundary.**
