

1. All items have individual bid sheets attached or affixed nearby. The opening bid is pre-determined and pre-printed on the bid sheets. Please write your bid number on the sheet next to the dollar amount that you wish to bid. If any entry is not legible, the next legible entry will be selected.
2. You may skip bid increments on the sheets as long as there is a dollar amount next to the line that you are signing. You must adhere to at least the minimum dollar amounts on the bid sheets. You must bid at least the minimum bid for each item. Failure to abide by the minimum bid or bid increment policy will render any bid void and the next properly placed bid will then be considered.
3. The silent auction tables will close at 8:00pm. A 15 minute warning announcement will be made prior to the auction closing, and then again at 5 minutes before it closes. The closing bid will be certified by an auction official and constitutes a winning bid. We ask our guests to honor the rules of the auction, by not bidding on an item once the auction has closed and to abide by the decision of auction officials. In the case of a dispute, the decision of the auction chair is final.
4. Checkout will be available at 8:30 near the auction area. Please do not try to checkout before this time. We accept checks, cash, Mastercard, Visa or AMEX.

- The Silent Auction is conducted by the Rotary Club of Albuquerque Metro.

- Each guest will be given a bid number upon arrival. This number is your only means of identification. Please keep it with you throughout the evening.

- Your bid number constitutes a legal offer to make a purchase. Designation of the bid you have written by the silent auction official as the top bid is a legal contract to buy that auction item. All sales are final with no exchange or refunds possible. In case of a dispute, the decision of the auction chair is final.

- We gladly accept your payment by cash, personal or corporate check, Visa, Mastercard or AMEX. Please make all checks payable to the Rotary Club of Albuquerque Metro. An electronic receipt suitable for tax purposes will be available. Payment in full is required on the evening of the event. The amount you pay in excess of the fair value of the item may be deductible as a charitable contribution. Please consult your tax advisor.

- The purchaser assumes the responsibility to remove purchases from the auction checkout area. All items must be removed the night of the event.

- Unless otherwise noted, all goods and services must be claimed and used within one year from the auction date. Please pay attention to all conditions, restrictions, and expiration dates on items and services.

Rotary Club of Albuquerque Metro reserves the right, without notice, to add or withdraw auction items.
