<u>Assembly Area:</u> Large dirt lot on Main St. between Wall & Vine. Entries will enter at Butler & Main St. Please do not trespass on The Coliseum property. Please wait in the large dirt lot staging area until the lineup begins, (keep in mind all military related participants will be lined up 1st). Come as decorated as possible.
