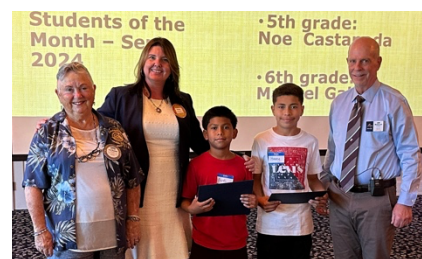
Students of the Month
