Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day

As we gather on Thursday, let us not forget that Dec. 7 is Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day. In 1994, Congress designated Dec. 7 as National Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day to honor the 2,403 service members and civilians killed during the Japanese



attack on Pearl Harbor on Dec. 7, 1941. A further 1,178 people were injured in the attack, which sank the USS Arizona and the USS Utah, destroyed 188 aircraft, and prompted the U.S. to declare war.
