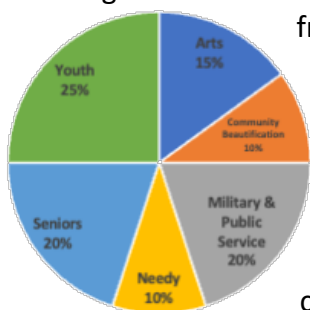




**Thursday's Program**
