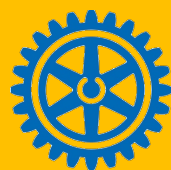

County voters established the CLERB in 1990 to independently and impartially investigate complaints against San Diego County Sheriff's deputies and probation officers. The board is composed of eleven volunteers from the County's five Supervisory Districts. Review Board members are nominated by the County's Chief Administrative Officer and appointed by the Board of Supervisors.
