November 9. Seventh graders Sophia Woodworth and Masen Gilliland were introduced by their Principal, Brian Frost. Way to go, Bulldogs!

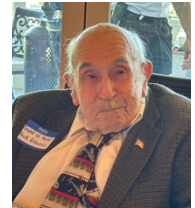
