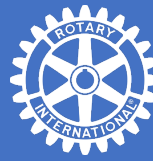

FUESD Facilities Bond Measure



We meet via Zoom this week. We will hear about the **FUESD's school bond measure**. The district has placed a \$76 million school bond extension measure on the November 3, 2026

ballot to repair and modernize local school facilities. The measure's structure proposes a bond extension keeping the tax rate flat. FUESD serves over 5,000 students from preschool through eighth grade across eleven schools and operates four additional support facilities throughout Fallbrook, De Luz, Camp Pendleton, and San Onofre. Five of the District's school campuses are nearly 60 years old or older, with two originally built in 1938!
