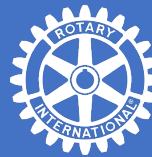

Spay Neuter Action Project



We are back at Grand Tradition this week. Our guest will be **Bill Bondshu** from **SNAP (the Spay Neuter Action Project)**. SNAP works to reduce the number of homeless animals coming into the shelter system. Two unaltered cats and their offspring can have over 400,000 kittens in 6 years and two unaltered dogs can have over 67,000 puppies in 6 years. SNAP's volunteers and medical professionals make it their mission to help reduce pet overpopulation and stop euthanasia in shelters.
