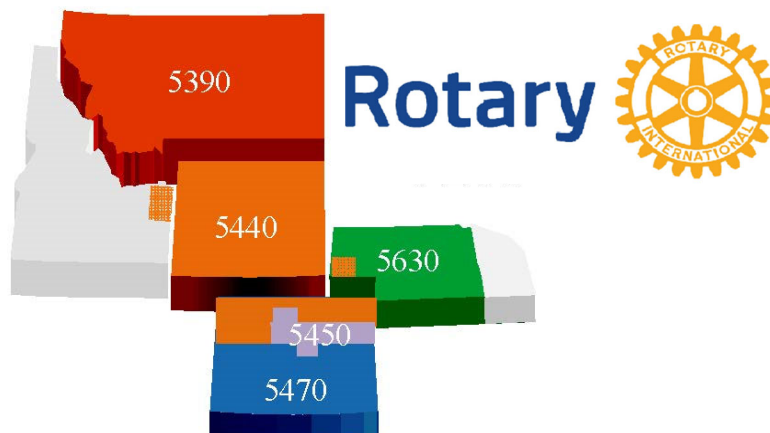

HINT to find meeting rooms: (the hotel runs north/south – the main entrance/lobby is on the north end)

River & Creek named – Ballroom Level (the lowest floor of the hotel). You may use the stairs to the right (south end of building) when exiting the ballroom to access the Atrium Level – you will come out by the Aspen room.

Town named – Atrium Level (the floor just above the Lobby). You may go between the Atrium level and the 3rd floor by using the stairs on the north end of the building. They are marked with signs.

Peak named – 3rd floor, north end.
