



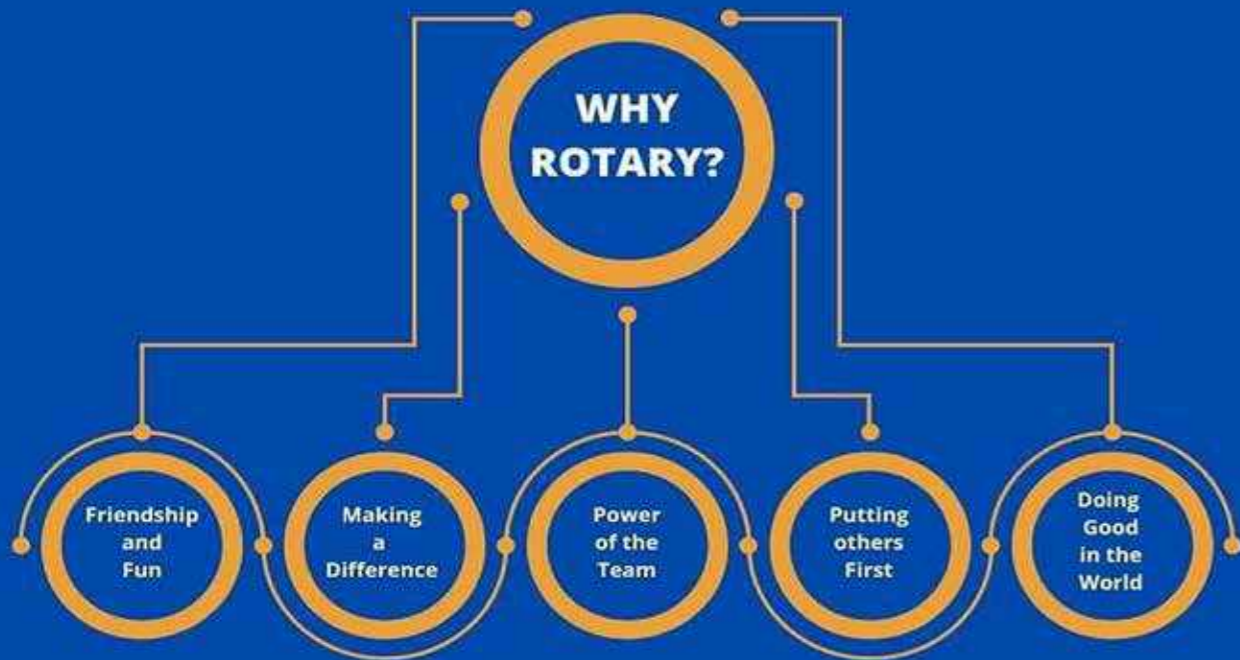

### November is over, and here comes the festive season

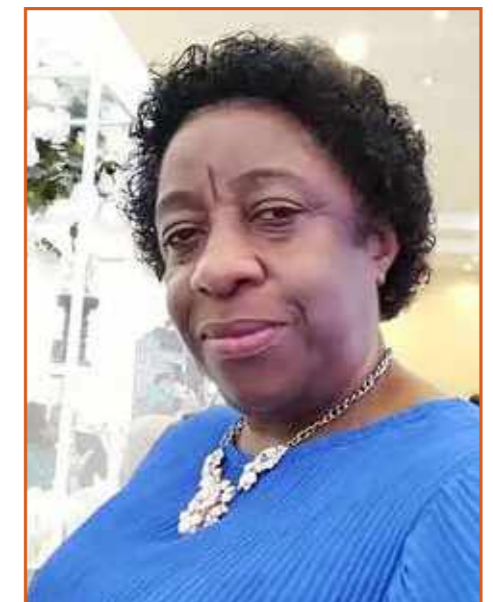
We are full of joy and gratitude for what we have been able to accomplish thus far. We thank you all for your support. We would never have been able to make it on our own.

## RI PRESIDENT'S NOVEMBER MESSAGE

Next year, Rotary takes a step toward supporting peacebuilding in the Middle East and North Africa region when recruitment begins for our newest peace center in partnership with Bahçeşehir University (BAU) in Istanbul.

A series of events in the coming year will recognize the new center at BAU and Rotary's work to promote peace.

The 2024 Rotary International Convention in May will mark 25 years since the first Rotary Peace Centers were announced — coincidentally at the Rotary Convention in Singapore in 1999.

Recruitment for the first cohort of Rotary Peace Fellows at BAU also starts in 2024, and selected candidates will begin their program in early 2025.

Since its beginning, the peace centers program has prepared more than 1,700 peace fellows working in more than 140 countries to create a more peaceful world. That is certainly worth celebrating, but Rotary Peace Fellows are more than statistics on a page.



Their actions have helped Create Hope in the World and will continue to do so.

For example, Jennifer Montgomery and Goret Komurembe — peace fellows from the program at Makerere University in Uganda — are co-founders of Magenta Girls Initiative.

The international nongovernmental organization equips Ugandan girls and young women with the support and tools

to overcome harmful gender norms, generational poverty, gender-based violence, trafficking, and trauma.

Ndzi Divine Njamsi, another peace fellow who studied at Makerere, has taken lessons learned about Positive Peace and is sharing them with students of his own in Cameroon. He became interested in the Rotary Positive Peace Activator training program after witnessing extremism, online hate speech, and violence in Cameroon.

Since completing the program, he has brought his lessons on peace to students at the Yaoundé International Business School and other organizations in the Central Africa country.

The world needs more people like the graduates of the program at Makerere and our other peace fellows. To that end, we can all advance peace by encouraging our local peacebuilders to learn more about Rotary and apply for this impactful fellowship. Rotary members can also mentor candidates for the fellowship. Or you can work with peace fellows who have already graduated. They probably have an initiative or two that would benefit from your help.

Our peace centers in North America, Europe, Africa, Australia, and Asia depend on financial support as well. The program at BAU was made possible thanks to a generous gift of \$15.5 million to The

Rotary Foundation from the Otto and Fran Walter Foundation.

This new Rotary Peace Center will offer a one-year professional development certificate in peace and development studies for fellows focusing on peacebuilding within the Middle East and North Africa region.

Peace must be waged persistently; it is the soil where hope takes root. But as with any journey, we take one step at a time. Let's take those steps together.

In this regard, I call upon Our Clubs to actively participate in the Rotary Foundation programs by utilizing grants from the foundation as well as contributing to it. Clubs/Rotarians can contribute to the Rotary Foundation through giving to Polio Plus, the Annual Fund and the Endowment Fund.

We are going to start our participation and celebrations as a District with the Rotary Foundation Dinner in Dar es Salaam on 1st November 2023, which is going to be



presided over by Our Rotary Foundation Trustee Martha Peak Helman. Special thanks to PDG Shamilah Bhatt and the Tanzanian Team for this Milestone. I am so thrilled by the generous contributions made by the Tanzanians so far.

On 3rd November 2023, D9214 is going to join with D9213 and the entire Rotary World into the Peace Concert aimed at raising funds for Our Makerere University Peace Centre. Again, the Concert is going to be graced by the Rotary Foundation Trustee

Martha Peak Helman. It is physically going to take place at the Speke Resort Munyonyo but it also has the virtual component. Allow me thank Past District Governors, Bob Waggwa Nsibirwa and Emmanuel Katongole for leading us in this campaign. I continue to call upon all Rotarians who have not yet booked their tickets for this event to do so at USD 100. Let us please support the cause. The second quarter of Our Rotary Year is going to greatly focus on raising money for Our Foundation as well as helping Our Clubs qualify and writing project concepts to get Global Grants. It is so saddening that by now, more than 60% of Our Clubs have given zero to the Polio Fund!! and over 50% have not given any Penny to the Rotary Annual and Permanent funds. This is totally unacceptable. Our ultimate goal this year is to have Our Clubs being 100% givers to the Foundation, we want to avoid having any zero giving Clubs to the Foundation this Rotary year! The Swahili have a Proverb "Kutoa ni Moya na Sla Utaziri" meaning that Giving comes from the Heart not from the Surplus.

Friends, let us embrace this heart of extending a Helping Hand to the less fortunate as we continue to Serve Above Self and Creating Hope in the World.

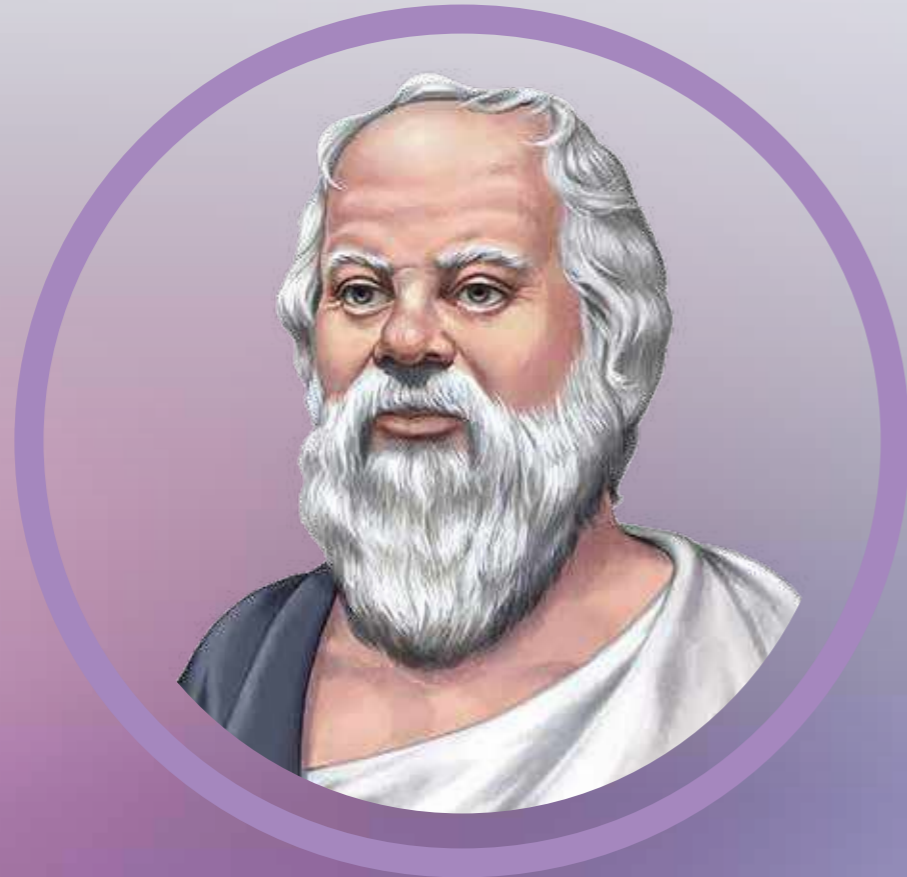

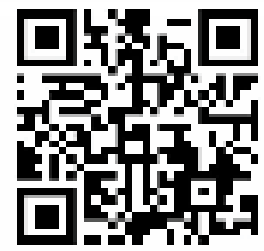
