Hosted by the Rotary Club of Salamander Bay and supported by the Rotary Clubs of Nelson Bay, Williamtown and Raymond Terrace upwards of 160 people attended the "World's Greatest Meal" at Soldiers Point Bowling Club this Wednesday evening.

A total of \$6305.95 was raised on the night and with the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation 2 for 1 support a total of \$18,917.85 will go to the End Polio Now Campaign.

As well as keynote speaker Suzanne Rae, those present heard from District Foundation Chair Peter Rayner, Salamander Past President Darcy Geale and early Polio sufferer Bob Gale (who wore callipers until the age of nine).

Speaker Suzanne Rae (also a Polio survivor) outlined her involvement stemming from her "lihghtbulb" idea of "The World's Greatest Meal", through to her subsequent promotion of the idea whilst travelling throughout the world including India, Pakistan and Uganda.

The stories heard were not new to Rotarians, but it was an excellent opportunity (and done well) to showcase the work of Rotary to the many non-Rotarians in attendance.

The proceeds from the meal, donated raffle prizes valued in excess of \$3500 and other donations resulted in the \$6306 profit.


