Two local schools, acknowledged Nelson Bay Rotary's contribution in securing much needed children's playground equipment. **Anna Bay Primary** School P&C President. Renee Thompson was present to thank our Club for both their financial contribution and other assistance on Thursday night. Renee has worked tirelessly over the past 4 years to secure funding.



After securing grants for the years K1 to Year 2 Playground equipment, Renee then gained additional grants, for the year's 3-6 playground equipment, plus funding, including \$10,000, given in June 2016, and \$1,700, being the net proceeds from our BBQ at the Schools Spring Fair held in October 2016,. Unfortunately the school principal Matt Freeman was unable to attend, however the Year 6 students put together a great video clip, which we showed on the night, thanking our Club for our support and genoristy. Renee is certainly has been a great Volunteer for the School.

Other guest speaker from Tomaree Special Education School, Trudie Blachford was unable to attend through illness. President Kathy presented a slide show, prepared by Trudie, Her commitment to this project was also outstanding raising over \$76,000 to have this project completed. Nelson Bay Rotary contributed over \$4,500 to this equipment, which was recognised in the presentation. All members can be justifiable proud of the Club's contribution. Both playgrounds were recently opened and our Club recognised.


