A busy day at the recent Bunnings BBQ has resulted in excellent profit of approximately \$1200.

An extra donation of \$100 was approved to send to CWA for the great efforts they made on catering for the Roadwhyz day.

Also an extra \$100 is to be sent to Roadwhyz management to cover the extra students who attended on the day above what had been paid for . Around 220 students attended on the day. The Roadwhyz program is booked for Friday August 23 in 2024 and the schools have been advised to reserve the date in their calendars.

The Science Discovery day was a huge success and the request was made to hold it again in 2024. Secretary Don is to write to Tomaree High School to thank them for use of the hall, and comment on the the staff and year 10 students friendly attitude, as well as the school grounds assistant involved in the set up.
