Vicky Gray - Centennial Scholar

The Nelson Bay Rotary Centennial Scholarship started in 2005 and Vicky (nee´ McEvoy, now Mrs Lightfoot) is our 5th such scholar. As our Historian (Richard Turner) pointed out, all scholars must do studies that benefit residents of the Tomaree Peninsula. As the full-time nurse at the palliative care centre in Nelson Bay, Vicky does that. Her studies at Flinders University were intended to make her "better at my job; not to get a better one". Much of the work by Vicky and her 3 staff involves counselling, such as helping clients to cope with "disenfranchised grief" (not recognised by others). It is holistic medicine. Her research topic will be "death bed phenomena" — which will lead to another talk here, we hope.


