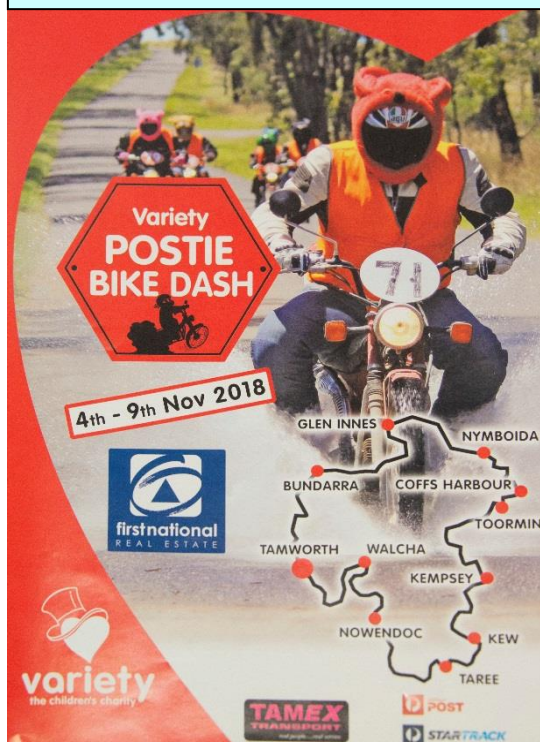


Bulletin # 16, 11th October 2018



Our intrepid Sergeant Warwick Mathieson is again setting off on the Variety Club Postie Bike Bash fund-raiser.

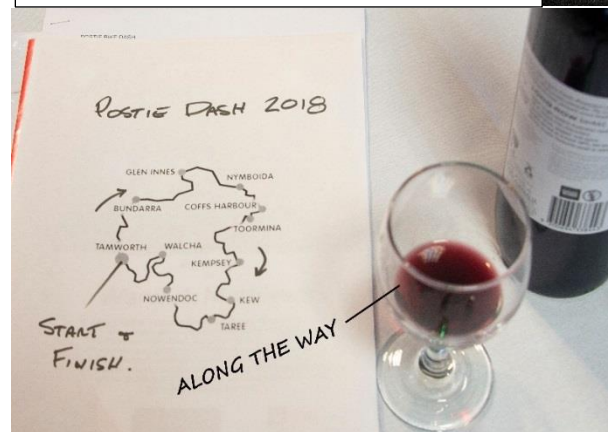
This year the trek will start in Tamworth travelling the North West and North Coast.
