The process of finding a suitable road and then gaining permission from the police and authorities was only part of the battle, as filming it was also difficult, with none of the modern film effects available. They were able to close the Boulevard in Melbourne which follows along the Yarra River for 2 hours. The scene lasted 4 minutes in the movie. Peter's earlier film was called "Now or Never" and was based on the escape of a Russian stewardess, Nina Paranyuk, from the S.S. Gruzia. This film was shown at the Moomba festival where it won first prize, and was later shown overseas.
