## **ROTARY** AT A GLANCE

Rotarians: 1,231,573 in 35,537 clubs in 540 Districts in 220 countries/geographic areas.

Rotaractors: 225,239\* in 9793 clubs in 529 districts in 179 countries/geographic areas.

Interactors: 481,160\* in 20,920 clubs in 497 districts in 160 countries/geographic areas.

Rotary Community Corps members: 204,194\* in 8878 clubs in 235 districts in 90 countries/ geographic areas.

Down Under there are 29,412 Rotarians in 1111 clubs in 21 districts in Australia and 8573 Rotarians in 268 clubs in six districts in New Zealand and the Pacific. Australian and New Zealand districts include Nauru, Papua New Guinea, Solomon Islands, Timor Leste, American Samoa, Cook Islands, Fiji, French Polynesia, Kiribati, New Caledonia, Norfolk Island, Samoa, Tonga and Vanuatu, where there are 811 Rotarians in 45 clubs.
