Jennifer & Marisa presented us the wonderful organisation path2change (www.path2change.org.au).

Their mission is to break the cycle of Homelessness, not only prevent but to reduce homelessness.

In NSW (more than any other state) has approx. 28,000 people homeless, 60% male 40% female due to family breakdown, violence, poverty, unemployment due to lack of education & work experience that limit job prospects and income.

Government partly funds the program for 15-24 year old, but as a charity they still rely heavily on community support.
