Don was also a member of Tomaree Probus Club, with incoming President and former Nelson Bay Rotary Mike Mobbs alerting us to Don's suddent death

Mental health advocate and defender of industrial rights, Don McDonald AM, has died at 79, from the complications of preventative pre-cancer surgery. Mr McDonald organised the Lifting the Lid on Mental Illness forum in Nelson Bay in May 2017, which attracted 500 people. This was to be one of his final acts, in retirement, after a lifetime of achievement. Mr McDonald was a Member of the Order of Australia, having been a career-union official and co-founder of the Schizophrenia Research Institute of Australia (SRI).

Don left the union in 1990 when his son Warwick developed schizophrenia. He led an alliance of concerned organisations and individuals which resulted in a \$2 million commitment, between 1996 and 2001, to establish SRI. The Neuroscience Institute for Schizophrenia and Allied Disorders was the forerunner to SRI.Doctors had diagnosed Don with a predisposition to pancreatic cancer. As a precaution, under specialist advice, he agreed to undergo a whipple procedure, to remove the head of the pancreas, the first part of the small intestine (duodenum), the gallbladder and the bile duct. While they were able to remove the benign legions, he would develop fatal complications. A service for relatives and friends was held in Sydney on Friday.

Editor's Note

Don was a member of the Nelson Bay Veterans Golf Club, which our VP John Stuhmcke is President and several of our Club's members play regularly. Our Club was able to assist Don in organising the Lifting the Lid on Mental Health Forum held in May 2017 at West Diggers, with Don Whatham, Judy Mitchell, DG Helen and Chris Bartlett involved. Chris is District 9670 Australian Rotary Health representative. The Neura Research Foundation, has strong links, to both Schizophrenia Australia Foundation and Australian Rotary Health. ARH's Lifting the Lid on Mental program is gathering force nationally with a public campaign being launched to raise \$20 million through business & corporate sponsorship for 9 areas of Mental health research throughout Australia.. Also thank you to the Port Stephens Examiners Sam Norris. Sam is a recently inducted member of the satellite Club of Rutherford Telerah.
