

# PRICE INCREASES ON BEVERAGES

The recent recycling rebate on bottles and cans offered by the NSW State Government, is hitting home. We have noticed a big price rise lately.



Our purchasing team spied this sign at Woolworths this week when stocking up on soft drinks for future events. The 10 cent recycling rebate plus a Government handling fee are highlighted on the sign. While soft drinks have increased by an average of 20% per can, the Editor was informed of massive increases in beer cartons, averaging around \$12.00 per carton. This is approx a 25% increase.

We still make very reasonable margins on soft drinks at water at major events, while Bunnings are currently reviewing their pricing structure.
