... makes for a dull Rotary night. So, Dieter had got hold of a YouTube video to remind us all that we are getting “older”. The video showed Fritz Coleman as the “Aging Keynote Speaker” covering a wide range of subjects for the elderly: from the advantage of having grandchildren to visits to the urologist...

Fritz Coleman (born 27/05/1948 in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania) is a weathercaster for KNBC-TV in Los Angeles, California for 31years. After he grew up in Radnor, Pennsylvania, he attended Salem College in West Virginia and Temple University in Philadelphia where he studied radio, television, and film.

Like many popular weather anchors, he serves as a weather reporter rather than a meteorologist contrary to popular belief he doesn't have a degree in meteorology.

He worked as a comedian and disc jockey for several years and as a radio personality at WBEN and later WKBW in Buffalo, New York.

He left Buffalo for Los Angeles in 1980 to work as a stand-up comic. In 1982 he began work as weekend weatherman at KNBC, and has been the weekday weatherman since 1984.

Growing old his way won't be too bad.....
