The arrival of the latest Strike Force (F35a) jets heralded a huge expansion and upgrade of the RAAF Facility at Williamtown which our speaker this week Wing Commander Mick Duggan found himself in charge of - somewhat by default.

Having retired from the RAAF after 43 years he walked back into a job the day after his retirement and following the death of a superior and the resignation of another Mick found himself elevated to the position of Base Re-Development Officer.

It might sound like a bit of a "Bradbury", but with what Mick has achieved it was obvious that he was destined to be the one.

Coming to the job in 2014 Mick has overseen the spending pf \$1.5 Billion (yes billion) on infrastructure - ranging from runway extension to new hangars, to workshops, to fuel truck shelters, to accommodation block (for seconded/temporary staff etc – there are no permanent residents on the base these days), pool and sports facilities and flight and air traffic simulators. In addition, a five-storey administration building for 1000 workers is under construction to house various staff from all service arms. As well, there ae some 20 minor projects currently under way.
