Her daughter, that had entered various smaller pageants and through that she received the call from the organizer in Miami FL. if she was interested and was surprised how much the organizer already knew about her from social media such as Facebook etc.

Initially she thought a girlfriend was

playing a bad joke on her, but soon she realized it was "fair dinkum".

The focus is on women empowering women and communities and general charities support. Her chosen platform is the [Create Foundation](#) this is a National Consumer body representing the voices of the children and young people with an out-of-home care experience (foster care). Her passion is creating, inspiring, unifying and support within her local community.

After her crowning in Sydney their first visit was to the Westmead Children's Hospital and Ronald McDonald House with books and games. In a few weeks she will be competing against 72 contestants from around the world in the USA representing Australia.

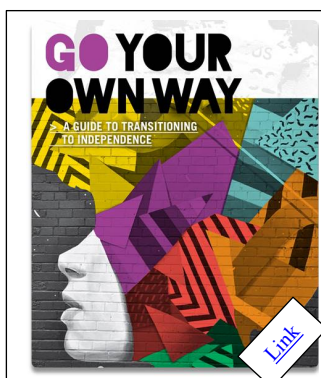

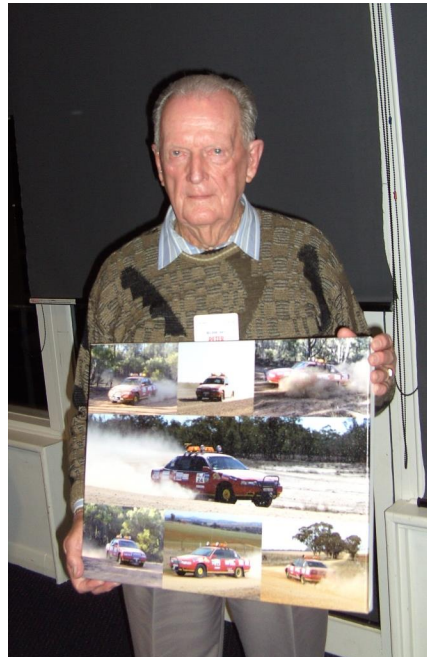
