RYDA VS ROADWHYZ?



Club members were treated to a very professional presentation by Senior Constable Jason Wright of the Port Stephens Traffic Control Division. Jason of Anna Bay is well known to Club members in his role as a Presenter at the Club's Rotary Youth Driver Awareness Program held in May each year.

He is also a presenter of the Roadwhyz program and was able to give us a great comparison between the two programmes. Jason felt while RYDA had some good aspects, he felt that today's young drivers needed a harder hitting program. He showed some very graphic images of local fatal and serious injury accidents, plus a very confronting video of a multiple fatality accident where 5 young people lost their lives after attending a party.

Jason explained the worst part of his job was the 4 am door knock where the family of road fatality had to be informed. On the surface the RoadWhyz program appears to get the message through better to young drivers. Geoff Diemar, Kathy Rimmer and Arja Levonpera will look into possible changes to our Driver Awareness Day and report their findings back to both the Board and the Club. It certainly was a powerful presentation delivered by Jason.




