Isha gave us an excellent presentation about the Ronald McDonald House in Newcastle. RMH was founded in Philadelphia 1974 by Football star Fred Hill whose daughter was treated for leukemia. McDonalds sponsor only 10%, rest of funding has to be raised by private donations. Camperdown became the 1st outside of USA.

Newcastle opened in 1991 (celebrating 25 years) with currently 12 rooms & 6 units with approx. 1000 stays per annum.

The family rooms get >10k family visits and provides a homely stay & much needed moral & emotional support with some R&R for parents and families during their child's illness.

The daily tasks such as cleaning maintenance etc. are all carried out by volunteers.

A vocational visit is planned for later in the year.
