Guest Speaker – Jeremy Scott

Jeremy was born with a hole in his heart, and his experiences as a child who survived open heart surgery at 5, was a life changing experience that eventually led him to become an adventurer with a love of the great outdoors. In 2011 Jeremy set out from London to travel across the globe lone and on a bicycle.

The extraordinary journey through Europe, Asia Minor, the Middle East, the Far East and finally through Australia finished 2 1/2 years and 52,000 km later in Auckland New Zealand..

At the completion of that life changing journey, Jeremy wrote his first book "The Long Road from a Broken Heart" and is now dedicating his life to inspire others. During his epic ride and beyond, Jeremy raised over \$30,000 for the New Zealand, Australian and British Heart Foundations and continues to support these charities through speaking engagements and book sales.
