It also points to the continual intellectual inventiveness from people who want to make a real and positive difference.

Guest Speaker: Janet Hay, RC Canterbury "Micro-finance"

Janet spoke about the work being done to assist communities in poverty with small micro-loans.

The idea is to lend small amounts of money to those in need who can see a way to better the situation but who do not have the means to do so without assistance. Small loans are offered without the requirement of collateral. Loans are repayable and hence not "charity" but a helping hand.

The traditional charity model often does little to address poverty. By lending small amounts of money to those with ideas there is the opportunity for them to become self-sufficient and also maintain self-esteem as loaned funds must be repaid.

The concept gained wider global support as a result of work done by Dr Yunus and Grameen Bank the recipients of a Nobel peace Prize for their work in 2006.
