

Duncan Elliott - CEO North East Link



Our guest speaker this week was the CEO of the North East road link

Work is underway on a North East Link to complete the missing link in joing Melbourne's outer east with the south east.

Duncan outlined the objectives of North East Link whichhe says will ease road congest; take trucks off local roads, and provide a link direct to Melbourne airport. The overall aim is to shorten travel times. The project is expected to create about 5000 jobs during planning and construction.

Duncan Elliott commenced his career with VicRoads as a graduate civil engineer. He progressed through a number of operational positions, leading to a Regional management role.

He then moved to the RACV at an executive level where he learned the power of influence through communication with people.

A few months ago he was offered and accepted the position of managing the North East link project. This represented a change in focus from one emphasising the use of influence to one which increased the doing element of the role.

A screen diagram illustrated how the project is to link the end of the M80 freeway at Greensborough, with the M3 freeway at Ringwood. The early work is to research the most appropriate route, recognising whichever route is chosen will negatively effect some element of the population. However there are big positives too. Duncan explained how there were 3 distinct population growth areas within the range of potential routes and the challenge was to balance the effects on the population and the environmental impacts. One of the major elements to the route selection was the varying topography involved, which impacts on the potential use of tunnels, bridges and other structural concerns.

When considering the decisions which need to be made, the extent and complexity of the issues involved, will influence his interaction with the public. His resolve is to be completely honest and comprehensive. This resolution was largely influenced by his Rotary experiences. The vehicle for much of the communication to the public will be via digital media.
