



The Rotary Club of Beechworth Jack Tully Memorial Scholarship

The Rotary Club of Beechworth offers a Jack Tully Memorial Scholarship to students embarking on their first year of university study.

Awarded annually, prospective candidates need to meet the following criteria for the \$2,000 scholarship:

- Be an Australian citizen or permanent Australian resident.
- Be enrolled as a first year, full-time student in an accredited undergraduate degree in Australia in the year in which the scholarship is awarded.
- At the time of application be:
 - a student at Beechworth Secondary College, or
 - a student attending any other secondary school in the North-East of Victoria or Murray Border Region but residing within a 20 km radius of the Beechworth Post Office.

Applications must be lodged by **December 12th 2024** and are to be accompanied by two referee reports, one of which must be from the last secondary education provider attended.

Receipt of any other bursary, scholarship or similar funds does not disqualify applicants from receipt of this scholarship, but the details of other applications and receipt of funds must be disclosed.

Selection for this scholarship will consider personal and academic merit. It is intended to support students of Beechworth to attend further studies at a University. This will be determined according to successful completion of VCE and general merit will be assessed from the application, referees and interview.

The scholarship must be taken up in the year in which it is offered; acceptance of the scholarship offer cannot be deferred. If a student declines the scholarship offer, the scholarship will be offered to the next eligible student.

The submission of an application does not guarantee the award of the scholarship and the Club reserves the right not to award a scholarship in any year should there be no suitable applicants. The Rotary Club of Beechworth's award decision shall be final with no appeal.
