

Youth Science for Year 11 Students

The National Youth Science Forum (NYSF) is a prestigious summer school program designed for Year 11 students who are transitioning into Year 12 and aspiring to pursue careers in science, engineering, and related disciplines.



Key Features of NYSF:

- » Target Audience: The NYSF caters to young individuals with a passion for science, specifically students in Year 11 and 12 from all regions of Australia.
 - » Engaging Program: The NYSF offers an immersive two-week science experience at the beginning of Year 12. Participants delve into various aspects of science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) through hands-on and digital activities.
 - » Rotary Partnership: Rotary, a founding partner of NYSF, plays a crucial role in supporting students who wish to participate. Rotary Districts from across Australia collaborate to select over 600 students for this enlightening program.
 - » Inspiring Futures: Beyond scientific exploration, the program aims to develop leadership and communication skills in participants. Networking opportunities are provided to help students lay the foundation for their future careers in STEM fields.
 - » Location and Timing: The NYSF is held in Canberra every January, offering a conducive environment for learning and collaboration.

- » Long-Term Relationships: Students supported by Rotary often maintain contact with their supporting Rotary Club, fostering long-term relationships. These students may further develop their leadership skills through Rotary youth pathways.
 - » Reporting and Presentations: In return for Rotary support, students may be asked to report back to their sponsoring Rotary Club. This could involve giving a presentation on their NYSF experiences or participating in other Rotary events.
 - » Collaboration with Rotary: The NYSF acknowledges and appreciates the collaboration with Rotary Clubs throughout Australia. Rotary's involvement extends to various aspects of the program, including promoting the opportunity within local schools and communities.

- » Funding Support: Students interested in attending the NYSF program are encouraged to approach Rotary Clubs for potential support. While Rotary Clubs are not obligated to provide assistance, many students benefit
