### Details required to report littering

1. Time
2. Date
3. Location – street, suburb, cross road
4. Number plate
5. State of registration
6. Vehicle details - make, model, colour
7. Litter type – cigarette, paper/plastic, food wrapper, drinks container, other – specify
8. Litter dropped, thrown, blown, placed
9. Offender details – gender, age, hair colour/length
10. Your location - footpath, car bus etc.
